Gorguze (BS MTL '41) whose leadership gift enabled the College to erect an addition to EPB. This past May the Regents formally re-named EPB and the new addition as the Gorguze Family Laboratory.

## GG Brown Addition

Plans are continuing for the construction of an addition to GGB. Final construction documents will be printed for review in early November and the design team is set for Regental approval to bid the project at their December meeting. After approval, the documents will be distributed for

bids. A bid opening will take place in late January, 2012. This is followed by an award process and the beginning of construction. It is anticipated that the GGB parking lot (NC-20) will be closing in late February and construction will begin in March and last through March, 2014.

## PML Addition & Renovation

Construction has started on the addition to the Phoenix Memorial Lab building on Bonisteel Boulevard. Currently the greenhouse on the southwest corner of the site is being demolished.

During the week of October 24 excavation should begin for the new basement area. Construction should last through 2012. During this time parking will be eliminated in front of PML along Bonisteel and the sidewalk

has been rerouted. Take extra caution when walking and driving in this area. In addition to the new construction, the 2<sup>nd</sup> level of PML is being renovated. When complete, the Michigan Memorial Phoenix Energy Institute will occupy the new spaces.

# Package Handling

Due to an increased level of mail bombs in Europe, Central and South America, OSEH is reminding us to be wary of suspicious packages. If you receive a suspicious package, evacuate the area where the package is located and call **911**. Describe the package and provide any information you have on how it

was delivered and by whom. Notify the Building Emergency Coordinator. **Do not** activate the building fire alarm system. The decision to expand the evacuation will be determined by the Dean's Office in conjunction with the DPS and CoE Facilities Management Office.

If an evacuation is initiated, follow the evacuation procedures outlined in the Emergency Action Plan.



## Things to look for:

- Foreign mail, air mail, and special deliveries
- Restrictive marking such as "confidential" or "personal"
- Excessive postage
- Handwritten or poorly typed address
- Incorrect titles
- Misspellings of common words
- Oily stains or discoloration's on package
- Excessive weight

- Rigid, lopsided, or uneven envelopes
- Protruding wires or tinfoil
- Excessive tape or string
- Visual distractions
- No return address

If you are suspicious of a mailing and are unable to verify the contents with the addressee or sender:

- Do not touch or move the article
- Do not open the article
- Evacuate the immediate area

- Do not put in water or a confined space such as a desk drawer or a filing open windows in the area to assist in venting potential explosive gases

If you have any reason to believe a letter or parcel is suspicious, do not take a chance or worry about possible embarrassment if the item turns out to be innocent; instead, contact DPS at **911** for assistance.
